the Active Voice

The active voice is the form of the verbal form or the verbal group that indicates that the subject of the clause is either [1] the doer of the action or [2] the feeler of the state [of mind].

Examples

In the underneath example, i.e. 'I saw her yesterday.', the subject is the doer of the action. 'I saw her yesterday.' is in the 1st Simple Timely Past Active Interweavement, which emphasizes a specific time in the past, and which [1st 1.1] [in 1st the indicative mood] indicates [in + the positive] that the subject performed the action at a specific time in the past (the specific time in the past, in this case, is specified by the adverb of time 'yesterday'). This example is in the active voice.

In the underneath example, i.e. 'He loves her.', the subject is the feeler of the state [of mind]. 'He loves her.' is in the 13th Simple Timely Present Active Interweavement, which [13th 13.1] [in 1st the indicative mood] indicates [in + the positive] that the subject feels the state [of mind] at all times. This example is in the active voice.

In the underneath example, i.e. 'Somebody has murdered her.', the subject is the doer of the action. 'Somebody has murdered her.' is in the 16th the 16th Compound Resultant Present Active Interweavement, which [16th 16.1] [in 1 the indicative mood] indicates [in + the positive] that the subject has performed the action before the time of speaking. The indefinite pronoun 'someone' indicates that the doer's identity is unknown. This example is in the active voice.

In the underneath example, i.e. 'The dog is chasing the cat.', the subject is the doer of the action. 'The dog is chasing the cat.' is in 22nd the 22nd Compound Continuous Present Active Interweavement, which 22nd 22.1 [in 1st the indicative mood] indicates [in + the positive] that the subject → is performing the action during the time of speaking. This example is in the active voice.







































In the underneath example, i.e. 'I will do it tomorrow.', the subject is the doer of the action. 'I will do it tomorrow.' is in 25th the 25th Compound Timely Future Active Interweavement, which 25th 25.1 M5.4 [in 1st the indicative mood] [with M5.4 the modal verb 'will'] indicates [in + the positive] that the speaker will perform the action at a specific time in the future, i.e. the speaker has every intention of performing the action at a specific time in the future (the specific time in the future is specified by the adverb of time 'tomorrow'). This example is in the active voice.










































Note Well
